Tarot Reader and Psychic Teacher: Background Profile

Fascinated by the Tarot cards since his teens, Tim was introduced to the art of psychic reading by his grandmother. This skill had been passed down in his family from his Great Grandmother's association with the English Gypsies. This valuable family tradition found an enthusiastic student in Tim, whose life long interest in the Tarot has developed in him a skilled talent.

Continuing to explore the psychic experience throughout his adult life has developed in Tim a keen intuitive sense, which he uses for many satisfied clients. He has gone on to lecture on the subject at tertiary institutions, publish his work in books and magazines, and developed a number of practical workshops and study retreats.

Another great passion of Tim's is Wicca, an earth centred spiritual practice sometimes described as the original spiritual heritage of the European Shaman. Tim has run workshops and ongoing Circles for a number of years exploring the teachings of contemporary Wicca, Alchemy, the Western Mystery Tradition and Shamanism. He has a non-fundamentalist approach to these studies.

He has completed several courses in Jungian based Archetypal Psychology and Dreamwork through the University of Sydney and the C.G.Jung Society of Sydney. The value of the Jungian approach to dreams, symbols and understanding the nature of Self is used as an important adjunct to Tim's appreciation of the esoteric and his psychic development. A keen reader, he has collected more than two thousand non-fiction books covering Mythology, Psychology, Anthropology, Divinatory Arts and Western Mystery Traditions.

In 1999 he founded a free on-line eGroup for people with interests in wicca and the esoteric. The group currently has more than 1200 members from across the country and is the largest Australian eGroup of its type.

Author and Media

Tim is a contributing author and designer of an Australian book on contemporary Wicca (pub.2003 Allen and Unwin) "Practising the Witch's Craft - real magic under a southern sky"; and has contributed to several other books. Earlier in his career he hosted a number of radio programmes including shows on ABC-fm, 5DN and 5MMM-fm Adelaide. He has been a special guest with Andrew Denton on ABC radio.

Currently he is working on several writing projects and running workshops and classes on the Tarot, Wicca, Alchemy, Shamanism, and Psychic Development.

Developing Your Psychic Reading Through the Tarot

The Tarot can be used as one of the most effective tools to help us access the intuitive and psychic function in each of us. The rich metaphor of alchemical images and mythology are explored as the natural symbol-forming language we use to communicate with our intuitive mind.
